Islington Golf Club is a private club founded in 1923, during the “Golden Age” of golf course construction and designed by renowned architect, Stanley Thompson. Surrounded by 6500 yards of golf course parkland in Toronto’s west end with Mimico Creek winding its way through tree-lined fairways, the club is a wonderful place to enjoy a day on the links. Over the past seven years Islington Golf Club invested almost ten million dollars in course and clubhouse upgrades. We welcome you to our club and the following will provide you with some information to help you with your visit.

WHEN YOU ARRIVE

Please drive into the bag drop area and check-in with the starter. You can then park your car in the upper or lower parking lot. Please proceed to the golf shop located on the main level of the clubhouse. The golf shop staff will greet and accompany you to the locker room or one of the lounges. You can use our practice facilities while you wait for the other players in your group to arrive.

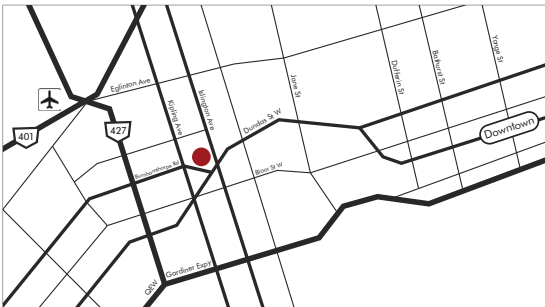
PERSONAL COMMUNICATION DEVICES

All personal communication devices must be set on vibrate or silent mode. Cell phone calls are only permitted in the parking lot or locker rooms provided that common courtesy is exercised at all times. Discreet, non-verbal (silent) communication, e.g., text messaging, emails and scheduling is permissible.

PACE OF PLAY GUIDELINES

All rounds of 18 holes should be played within 4 hours and 2 minutes or less, with no more than a 13-minute gap between the group that immediately preceded you on the first tee. Play ready golf!

The club is located at 45 Riverbank Drive, off the west side of Islington Avenue, one street north of Dundas, and within easy access to public transit and a short driving distance of Pearson International Airport and the major highways. In addition, our site offers ample complimentary parking.

DRESS CODE POLICY :: GOLF COURSE AND PRACTICE AREAS

ALL GOLFERS

Golf attire should be neat, tailored and consistent with the standards of the Club and tradition of the game of golf.

GENTLEMEN

The following are acceptable attire:

- Golf shirts with a collar, mock neck, or turtleneck; shirts must be tucked in at all times
- Tailored golf shorts, which must be no shorter than two inches above the kneecap
- Tailored golf pants

Not acceptable attire:

- Denim or jeans
- Cargo pants or shorts (large external pocket)
- Hats worn backwards
- T-shirts
- Sweatshirts with hoods, or slogans, numbers, and names that are not golf related
- Mid-calf length socks or socks which are rolled down to sockette or ankle length
- Open toe or exposed heels in shoes; socks must be worn with golf sandals

LADIES

The following are acceptable attire:

- Golf skirts and shorts which are at least mid-thigh in length
- Tailored slacks
- Sleeveless golf shirts which have collars, and collarless golf shirts which have sleeves

Not acceptable attire:

- Short shorts
- Tank tops or tops with exposed midriffs
- Leggings, exercise tights or yoga-type pants
- Open toe or exposed heels in shoes; socks must be worn with golf sandals
- Denim or jeans
- Cargo pants or shorts (large external pocket)
- Hats worn backwards
- T-shirts
- Sweatshirts with hoods, or slogans, numbers, and names that are not golf related

DRESS CODE POLICY :: CLUBHOUSE AND PATIO

The clubhouse and patio strives for a smart, casual environment consistent with private club standards.

The following are acceptable:

- Tailored, casual country-club attire
- Golf attire
- Smart denim or jeans in all areas

The following are not acceptable:

- Frayed, ripped, cutoffs or distressed jeans
- T-shirts
- Sweatshirts with hoods, or slogans, numbers, and names that are not golf related
- Exercise wear, leggings or tights, yoga-type pants, jogging pants, short shorts
- Gentlemen's hats in the clubhouse
