Surrounded by 6500 yards of golf course parkland in Toronto’s west end with Mimico Creek winding its way through tree-lined fairways, the club is a wonderful place to enjoy a day on the links.

WHEN YOU ARRIVE

Please drive into the bag drop area and check-in with the starter. You can then park your car in the upper or lower parking lot. Please proceed to the Golf Shop located on the main level of the clubhouse. The Golf Shop staff will greet and accompany you to one of the lounges. You can use our practice facilities while you wait for the other players in your group to arrive.

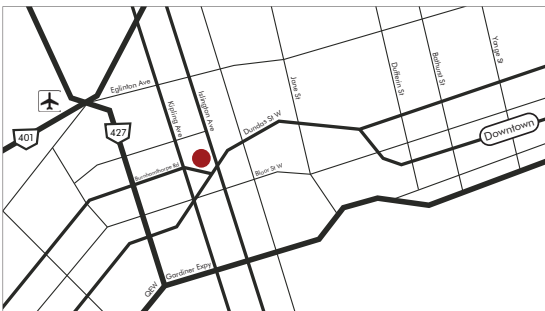
PERSONAL COMMUNICATION DEVICES

All personal communication devices must be set on vibrate or silent mode. Cell phone calls are only permitted in the parking lot or locker rooms provided that common courtesy is exercised at all times. Discreet, non-verbal (silent) communication, e.g., text messaging, emails and scheduling is permissible.

PACE OF PLAY GUIDELINES

All rounds of 18 holes should be played within 4 hours and 2 minutes or less, with no more than a 13-minute gap between the group that immediately preceded you on the first tee. Play ready golf!

DRESS CODE POLICY :: GOLF COURSE AND PRACTICE AREAS

Golf attire should be neat, tailored and consistent with the standards of the club and tradition of the game of golf.

The following attire is acceptable on the golf course or in the practice areas:

Gentlemen:

- Golf shirts with a collar, turtleneck, mock turtleneck, or blade/razor neck
- Shirts must remain tucked in
- Tailored golf shorts
- Tailored golf pants and banded-bottom golf pants

Ladies:

- Golf shirts must have a collar, or sleeves or both
- Racer back golf shirts must have a collar (no undergarments may be showing)
- Golf skirts/skorts/dresses and shorts should be mid-thigh length
- Tailored slacks, capri-length pants and banded-bottom golf pants (not made of sweatpant/jersey/lycra material)
- Leggings may only be worn under golf skirts/skorts/dresses and shorts

Outerwear:

- All logos should be golf related and in good taste

Footwear:

- Soft spiked shoes or golf sandals (worn with socks)

Headwear:

- Hats must be worn with the intended design

The following attire is not acceptable on the golf course or in the practice areas:

- T-shirts for gentlemen
- Tank tops, halter tops or tops with exposed midriffs (tube tops/crop tops)
- Denim pants and shorts or jeans
- Cargo pants/cargo shorts (large external pocket) and rugby pants
- Sweatpants, exercise tights, yoga-type pants and gym shorts
- Sweatshirts with hoods and/or slogans, numbers, and names that are not golf related

Footwear:

- Metal spikes
- Open toe or exposed heels in shoes

Events:

- Specific dress code requirements for events may be requested and will be communicated in advance.

Enforcement:

Under the direction and with the support of the Board of Directors, the Islington Golf Club's Pro Shop management and staff are responsible for enforcing the Golf Course and Practice Area dress code.

Members should inform management of any infractions and refrain from approaching members or guests directly. The Golf Shop staff are authorized, at their discretion, to refuse access to the course to any member or guest not meeting the dress code standards.

The Golf Shop is stocked with suitable clothing and any inadvertent errors may be quickly and easily corrected.

DRESS CODE POLICY :: CLUBHOUSE AND PATIO

The clubhouse and patio strives for a smart, casual environment consistent with private club standards.

The following are acceptable:

Attire:

- Tailored, smart casual attire
- Golf attire
- Smart denim or jeans

Footwear:

- Hard soled shoes, Soft soled shoes and Golf shoes
- Sandals and open-toed shoes

Headwear:

- Hats are only permitted on the patio and in the locker room

The following are not acceptable:

Attire:

- Frayed, ripped, distressed jeans or cutoffs
- Distressed or graphic T-shirts
- Sweatshirts with hoods and/or slogans, numbers, and names that are not golf related
- Exercise wear, leggings or tights, yoga-type pants, jogging pants, short shorts

Footwear:

- Beach flip flops, athletic-branded sports slides or Crocs

Headwear:

- Hats must be removed in the clubhouse (excluding formal wear and headwear worn for religious reasons)

Events:

- Specific dress code requirements for events may be requested and will be communicated in advance. This may include black tie and/or jacket.

Enforcement:

Under the direction and with the support of the Board of Directors, the Islington Golf Club's management and staff are responsible for enforcing the Clubhouse and Patio dress code.

Members should inform management of any infractions and refrain from approaching members or guests directly. Management and staff are authorized, at their discretion, to refuse service to any member or guest not meeting the dress code standards.
